WHAT IS THE HEARTLAND FILM FESTIVAL?

Heartland Community College is proud to announce its first ever film festival to be held on Thursday, April 9th in the auditorium of the John Astroth Community Education Center. As part of this year's festival, we are seeking submissions of short films from current and former Heartland students to be part of a special student film showcase.

WHEN DO I NEED TO SUBMIT MY FILM?

The deadline for all submissions is 11:59 p.m. CST on March 27, 2020 for consideration in this year's festival. The screening of selected student and alumni work will be held in the afternoon on Thursday, April 9th.

WHAT KINDS OF FILMS DO YOU ACCEPT?

We accept films of all genres, be they live-action, animation, documentary, narrative, experimental, etc.

WHO JUDGES/PROGRAMS THE FILMS?

A panel of Heartland professors will review the submissions, assemble a program of finalists for screening, and determine the top ranking films.

IS THERE A LENGTH LIMIT?

We prefer submissions of films under 30 minutes in length, but would consider longer films of exceptional quality.

WHO IS ELEGIBLE TO SUBMIT FILMS FOR THE FESTIVAL?

All current and former Heartland Community College students are eligible to submit films for consideration.

CAN FILMMAKERS WIN ANYTHING?

Yes! Prizes are available.

HOW DO I SUBMIT MY FILM?

Films should be submitted in the form of a link to a secure website (such as Youtube or Vimeo) or a Dropbox file (such as MP4, WMV, FLV, etc.) sent directly by e-mail to professor Adam Scott at Adam.Scott@heartland.edu
